

PoliTick - Everything about Tick-the-Code and Quality for Managers

Software developers can use **Tick-the-Code** on their own, but with proper management support their contribution can be much more valuable. PoliTick aims at answering the question: "How do I, as manager, best support my **Tick-the-Code** -enabled software developers?" There are things you need to understand about **Tick-the-Code** but there are also general quality issues to discuss, because introducing **Tick-the-Code** requires a paradigm change when it comes to quality.
